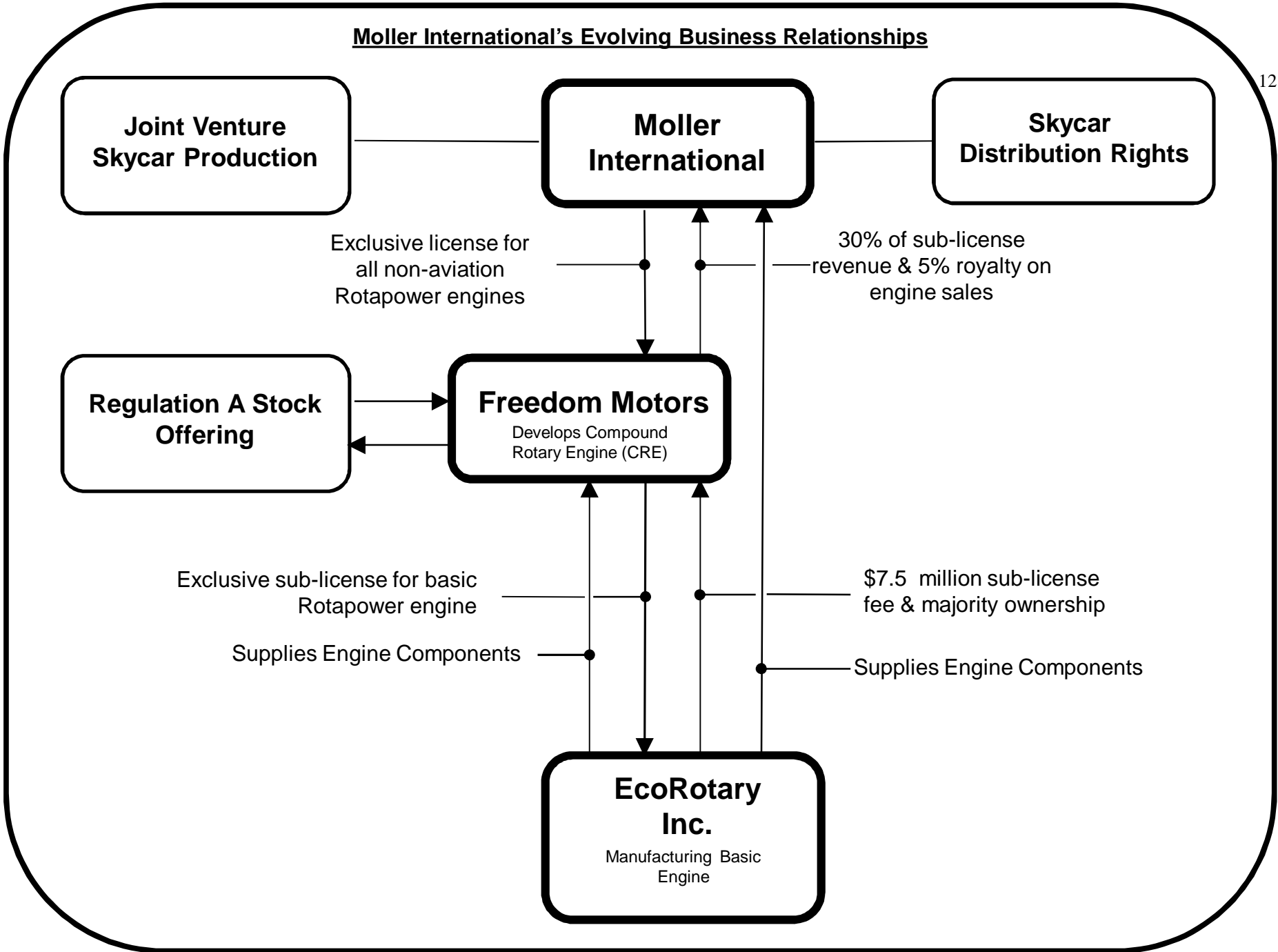

Background

- ▣ Rotapower engine key to Skycar and related aircraft technology
- ▣ The Rotapower engine develops a life of its own
- ▣ In 1997 Moller International (MI) exclusively licensed manufacturing of its Rotapower engine to Freedom Motors (FM) for all applications except aircraft and ducted fans
- ▣ FM found manufacturing climate in California poor and sought to license production of the basic Rotapower engine elsewhere
- ▣ EcoRotary, Inc. license and partnership evolves from this effort

Moller International's Evolving Business Relationships



Moller International - Activities in 2013

- ▣ Business support for Freedom Motors as it licensed EcoRotary, Inc.
- ▣ Liaised with the FAA to have certain models of the Skycar and Neuera classified under a subcategory of Power-Lift with more simplified rules.
- ▣ Developed Skycar models that could meet these Powered-Lift category requirements
- ▣ Undertook engine development specifically for the Skycar and achieved output of over 3 hp/lb.
- ▣ Sought a Joint Venture partner to help put the Skycar into production
- ▣ Obtained legal opinion of legality to explore our IP outside of the US.

Freedom Motors – Activities in 2013

- ▣ Prepared to make a SEC Regulation A offering of its stock
 - Completed responses to questions raised by the SEC
 - Goal was to have this offering to become effective concurrent with the receipt of funding for EcoRotary, Inc.
 - Expect offering to become effective before year-end
- ▣ Acquired letters of intent and conditional orders for over 3.5 million basic engines (~ \$5 billion in potential sales)

FM Funding Options Underway

- ▣ Investment consultant and “Excel Monkey” are preparing a “pitch deck” for identified investor in Freedom Motors.
- ▣ Artificial Life Sources Holdings (ALIFE) has proposed an LOI for over 1 million engines:
 - Initially for motorcycles
 - To be followed by engines for hybrid cars
 - Has MOU in process to provide \$500,000 for integration of FM engines into its products

MI Funding Options Underway

- ▣ Investment group, Skypoint, LLC, is planning to fund “proof of concept” phase of Skycar production
 - Has provided over \$500,000 in funds
 - Has hired a financial consultant to help create final funding proposal
 - Longstanding stockholder is key participant
- ▣ Crowdfunding campaign underway to fund the tether-free, manned public demonstration flight

Ongoing Efforts

- ▣ We continue to work with contacts in China:
 - Mike Shanley, MI Director and Far East Representative
 - John Gong, President of Athena Technologies
 - Ray Chung, President of V2V China Investment Fund Inc.

Goals for MI and FM for 2014

- ▣ Have EcoRotary begin Beta production of the basic Rotapower[®] engine (200 of each model – 150cc & 450cc)
- ▣ Conduct a flight test the Skycar[®] 400 prototype (M400X) and invite the 750+ members of the media who have requested to attend the event
- ▣ Work with the FAA to establish a powered-lift “LSA-like” sub-category
- ▣ Complete design of Skycar 200 and begin prototype production
- ▣ Provide American Space Industries (Russell Decker) with technical assistance in his efforts to put a 1/7th scale remotely controlled model of the Skycar 400 into volume production
- ▣ Fund “Proof of Concept” phase of Skycar 400 and Skycar 200
- ▣ Complete Regulation A offering for FM stock
